#### **Project Activity Snapshot**

#### Activities completed in the last two weeks WC 01/02/21 WC 07/02/21

- ✓ Conducted quality assurance for the cleansed Melbourne bank statement. Identified additional issues and limitations include:
  - The Melbourne statement format added random spaces between key words used in the data analytics model (e.g. "DEPOS IT"), which required further cleansing.
  - Inconsistent alignment of transactions caused credit numbers being merged into the incorrect transaction description (the next line), which required further cleansing.
- ✓ Completed data cleansing of Burswood bank statements. Additional resources have been allocated to
  ensure timely completion of data cleansing.
- ✓ Performed analysis of cash deposits <10,000 for the following scenarios on week-inclusive and weekend-exclusive basis to both Melbourne and Burswood statements (on the transactions that have numbers that are likely to be patron ID in the narratives):
  - Two or more cash deposits of <\$10,000 each, totalling \$10,000 or more in a 24hr period</li>
  - Two or more cash deposits of <\$10,000 each, totalling \$10,000 or more in a 48hr period</li>
  - Two or more cash deposits of <\$10,000 each, totalling \$10,000 or more in a 72hr period.</li>
- ✓ Identified and documented all transactions without patron ID in the descriptions.
- ✓ Preparing a list of transactions that are missing patron ID to be provided to Crown.
