**Notice regarding Casino Special Employee (CSE) convictions**

Dear Ms Fielding

I refer to your letter dated 10 July 2017 in respect of the conviction of 17 current and two former employees of the Crown Resorts Limited Group (Crown).

Understanding that the CSE's are currently incarcerated and court details of the conviction and statement of reasons have not yet been fully presented and assessed, the Victorian Commission for Gambling & Liquor Regulation (Commission) will not take any immediate action regarding the status of the employees as licensed CSE's.

However, I further advise that the Commission is continuing its ongoing review of this matter and will determine any further action regarding the status of the employees as CSE's licenced under section 57 of the *Casino Control Act 1991*, once it has assessed the statement of reasons applicable to the conviction.

Could you please provide further notification to the Commission once the CSE's are released, and if it is expected that the employees will return to their substantive duties in their capacity of employment with Crown, provide the Commission with prior notification of this return to employment and if they indeed will be performing the duties of a CSE.
