SEER is a person of interest and event data base, designed to capture information that will assist in the delivery of successful Surveillance investigations.

SEER was originally developed in 2006 to replace the Patron ID system at Crown Melbourne and it was developed in house by a technical and operational team. The main aim of the upgrade was to enhance data base security, improve usability, ensure data quality and provide useful operational reporting and searching.

SEER Version 2.0 is a client/server application used primarily by the Surveillance and Compliance department for maintaining information relating to Persons of Interest, Incidents and Intelligence to protect gaming integrity. A Person of Interest may be a patron, an employee or a 3rd Party Contractor to Crown. Other department that may be interested in such information includes:

- Security Department
- Table Games
- Customer Relations
- Gaming Machines
