Dear Commissioner,

As noted in the Alliance for Gambling Reform submission dated 31 May, I strongly support a universal, identity-linked cashless gambling card as an important harm minimisation strategy. I also wholeheartedly agreed with Commissioner Bergin's assessment of this as "a powerful mechanism to assist in combating money laundering".

The Bergin Inquiry recommended moving to a cashless payment scheme given the evidence provided regarding moneylaundering in Crown casinos. This was an important recommendation that would be made all the more powerful if found again in this instance. A recommendation supporting this proposal in Victoria would have implications not just for the casino operator, but for harm reduction policy settings across the nation.
