Patron known as called on behalf of her S/E brother a line regards to revocation. Privacy confidentiality protocols were explained to along with revocation procedure. Who claimed that her brother does not speak any English was also provided with PC's details.

Advised by Personal, the patron was currently playing Baccarat in pit 8.

On arrival I was met by Personal and Executive Host Leanne Personal who identified patron known as seated on BA0806. It was alleged that a Korean national currently residing in NSW has a tendency of gambling until he loses every thing and then approach Mahogany Management for assistance claiming he is penny less. Personal alleged that was in tears as he explained that his wife had just died in Korea and requested Crown pay for his airfare home. Personal as stated she did not believe his story as then requested Crown pay for his train ticket back to NSW as he has a fear of flying.

was observed on BA0806 for a period of 15 minutes. He did not place a wager and did not have any chips or cash in front of him. He was seated next to an Asian female who visible had approximately \$20,000 in chip in her possession.

Surveillance Operator Melanie was advised of the situation and requested to monitor for undesirable behaviour.
