

Received a call from Stuart in Surveillance regarding an alleged SE breach. He stated that a female patron had been an assisted removal from B2 Las Vegas exit and when she departed the female patron kicked her heels into a car parked just outside the entrance (Red Toyota Camry, Personal patron). The Camry happened to belong to SE patron

I attended and was met by Chubb Ops Mgrs Barry Personal and Shady Personal VicPol were also present. They took a statement from and charged the female aggressor. Personal questioned whether had been on the gaming floor. He initially denied this claiming he had been waiting 5 hours having coffee while his mother played Baccarat. Later in the conversation he stated he had been on the gaming floor when told we would check our systems.

was keen to show his sincerity in wanting to revoke and produced recent correspondence and revocation material that he was in the process of submitting to Crown. The 12 month breach-free period was emphasised and I informed him this incident would be noted on our files.
