Susan

I am having some difficulty approving these Linked Jackpot Arrangements with these very brief applications.

Although I am often assured that these applications are for a product identical to previous versions, I do need to have a complete record of what is being applied for in order to make the appropriate recommendation to the delegate.

Could you please respond to the following to assist me in progressing this application:

1. Please confirm that this is a request for approval of the linked jackpot arrangement pursuant to section 62B of the Casino Control Act 1991 and also an application for approval of the parameter sets under section 62 (2) of the Casino Control Act 1991. **Yes for s 62B, however s 62(2) relates to Gaming Equipment and no approval is being sought for Gaming Equipment.**
2. Could you please confirm that there will be no changes to the Bonus System or the DACOM system to support this jackpot? **There are no changes at this stage, however, as a jackpot may have various mechanics, any enhancements/changes required to the BS/Dacom system will be submitted for regulatory approval as per current process.**
3. Please clarify that the EGM range means the number of machines that the LJA can be linked to. I presume you want flexibility to connect this LJA to any or all of the EGMs at Crown. **Correct, this range indicated the minimum/maximum number of EGM's that can be connected to the jackpot.**
4. How often do you expect this jackpot will be paid out (average cycle times) for minimum and maximum increment rates if the LJA is connected to all gaming machines at Crown? **It's a bonus jackpot and so hit frequency will depend on parameters set.**
5. Could you please confirm that the start out value of this jackpot prize is \$5 as per column 5 of the attached table? Is the maximum value \$1M? When the maximum is reached will the prize go off or will contributions simply go into an overflow pool? **Minimum start out defines the lowest value a jackpot can start at and not necessarily what this jackpot will be configured to. It may start higher than \$5. Maximum value defines the maximum prize value that can be awarded, and therefore the prize value will never exceed \$1M.**
6. Terminology: Does the term "increment rate" apply to the rate at which the prize value on the signage increases? **Correct.**
7. What are the contribution rates to the special prize pool? I can't see them in the table. **Unsure of what you mean by "special prize pool".**
8. Is there any artwork that will be displayed with this jackpot or any other collateral? We need to assess the theme for responsible gambling issues. **All in-EGM artwork will be submitted for regulatory approval once developed as per the current legislative requirements and as per usual process.**

If you have a procedures manual for the operation of mystery jackpots, it may assist in answering my questions. Apologies if such a manual has previously been supplied to the VCGLR but I am not aware of one.
