In response to your request for further information.

- Any signed versions of such invoices, including those already produced to the Commission;
There are no signed versions of invoices.
- Any invoices relating to work completed at Mr Zhou's Toorak house;
Appendix A relates to an invoice provided to Tom ZHOU for removal of a wasp nest from his property arranged by Confidential. We only facilitated the removal not the invoicing.
Appendix D relates to a quote supplied by one of our previous contractors to do some lock maintenance upgrades at ZHOU's property in Toorak. Not sure what eventuated with this but we didn't handle any of the invoicing.
- Any invoices relating to work completed at cafes in which Mr Zhou argued for reduction in prices;
Not sure what this relates too as it sounds as if it is about ZHOU arguing about the pricing of café items off the menu. Assuming it might relate to our heated discussions with them in the food court at Crown in early November (Confidential told the Commission about) where there "accountant" was arguing about monies owed to us in regards to the final invoices that were supplied to you. That finished our dealings with them at that point. Zhou not present.
- Any documents recording the cessation of work by Confidential in or around October 2016.
Appendix B relates to cessation of work with Chinatown and advising them to pay their lawyers outstanding invoices for works done.
Appendix B (2) relates to dialogue between Confidential AND CHINATOWN in early November 2016 that shows our intention to cease all dealings with them. They had also told us that they no longer wanted to deal with us as the arguments continued over payments due.
Appendix C relates to all of the email invoices I kept forwarding across to Chinatown for payment of monies owed and requests for them to pay.
