Royal Commission into the Casino Operator and Licence (Royal Commission)

As you may be aware, the Honourable Linda Dessau AC, the Governor of Victoria, has established a Royal Commission to enquire into whether Crown Melbourne Limited (**Crown Melbourne**) is a suitable person to continue to hold the casino licence under the *Casino Control Act 1991* (Vic), whether Crown Resorts Limited is a Suitable Associate of Crown Melbourne, and related matters.

By Terms of Reference dated 22 February 2021 and amended on 25 February 2021, the Honourable Ray Finkelstein AO QC has been appointed Commissioner and Chairperson of the Commission.
